
The plan will now enter into a ten week public consultation period, ending on 16 January 2025. During this time, it is our intention to collect views on the plan's content from community, industry, the industrial workforce, and all others with a vested interest in the future of the Grangemouth industrial cluster.

Firstly, I would like to thank you for your ongoing insights that have helped the development of this work to date, largely through the Committee's inquiry into a Just Transition for Grangemouth. Specifically, your input has played a significant role in raising the profile of Grangemouth as a region that will be critical in meeting our climate ambitions feedback, as well as highlighting key areas for attention.

As you will be aware, we are developing this work in partnership with the Grangemouth Future Industry Board, which has approved this draft for publication. It is our ambition that the document becomes the strategic guiding framework that aids GFIB in decision-making as the industrial cluster transitions to net-zero. With your help, through consultation feedback, we hope to finalise a robust Just Transition Plan that is reflective of both our shared ambition for the future, and the action necessary to achieve this.

We would like to invite Committee members to consider the draft plan and coordinate a response to the consultation.
