- [Rosebank School in Dundee](#) was the first school to gain this accreditation in Scotland.
- The Award requires individual schools to approach us if they are interested in it. We also do some promotion of the Award to encourage schools to go through it. We are not currently working collaboratively and a local government or national government level on this.
