The **Scottish Parliament** makes laws in Scotland. It speaks out for the people of Scotland.


What this booklet is about



We are starting an **inquiry** to find out about healthcare in **remote** and **rural** areas of Scotland.



An **inquiry** is when we find out information about something.



Remote means an area far away from cities and towns.



Rural means an area in the countryside.



Before we start our inquiry, we want to find out what people think are the most important **issues** we should look at.



An **issue** is a problem or a worry someone has about something.
