THE PESTICIDES (REVOICATION) (EU EXIT) REGULATIONS 2022

The Scottish Parliament agreed on 7 December 2021 that it was content for Scottish Ministers to give their consent to the UK SI The Pesticides (Revocation) (EU Exit) Regulations 2022 including Scottish devolved matters, as set out in the notification to the Parliament on 19 August 2021.

The Pesticides (Revocation) (EU Exit) Regulations 2022 SI was made on 9 February 2022 under Section 8 of the European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018. I can now confirm that this SI is consistent with the consent granted.

This correspondence is being sent to you now as the Scottish Government is taking steps, as part of a review of the operation of the SI Protocol, to ensure a comprehensive audit trail is in place for each SI notification.
