I'm writing to inform you that the independent review of the enforcement of litter and flytipping offences report, which has been mentioned during the Committee's consideration of the Circular Economy Bill, has been published today on the Scottish Government's website and can be accessed via this link <https://www.gov.scot/isbn/9781836014003>.

Undertaking the review was a commitment in the Year One Action Plan for the National Litter and Flytipping Strategy. The review has highlighted that there is more that can be done to improve litter and flytipping enforcement in Scotland; and most stakeholders noted that there is no one solution to tackle the issue and that a joined-up and collaborative approach is needed, which is something the Scottish Government is committed to doing

A number of findings of the review are already being actioned through the delivery of the National Litter and Flytipping Strategy and will continue inform delivery going forward.
