Item 1

Introductions and Opening Remarks

Maurice Golden MSP (Convenor) welcomed everyone to the meeting. He explained that Maurice Corry (Chair) was unable to attend this meeting due to work commitments. With 3 MSP members attending and a further 46 non-MSP members attending, the Convenor was pleased to confirm that the meeting was quorate.

Agenda item 2

The Minute from the previous meeting, which had taken place on 21 February 2024, had been distributed for consideration by the members. It was agreed that the minute provided an accurate record of the meeting.

Agenda item 3

Annual Report and AGM. A draft copy of the Annual Return had been circulated, the Secretary went through the return and updated it to include attendance and discussion topics taking place that evening. The return, as

amended, was agreed by the Group so the Secretary would submit it on 20 June.

During the AGM, it was agreed that Maurice Golden MSP would continue as Convenor, Jackie Baillie MSP had previously agreed to continue as Deputy Convenor. Willie Rennie MSP and Gordon MacDonald MSP had both indicated that they would be stepping down as Deputy Convenors. It was noted that a representative MSP from the SNP should be invited to join the Group. The Convenor agreed that he would engage with the SNP to find an appropriate candidate.

The role of Chair would continue to be held by Maurice Corry, and of Secretary and Treasurer by Jim Wilson.

Item 4

An update on Veterans in the Criminal Justice System was provided,

- SACRO confirmed the work that is being carried out with veterans who have received custodial sentences and are in the process of being released from prison. SACRO work closely with Scottish Prison Service staff, in particular the ViCSO's, and with a range of other agencies and charities.
- Care After Combat highlighted the work they do, predominantly in England and Wales at present, however they are extending heir services into Scotland.

Item 5

Discussion on Employment and Op PROSPER

- Alistair Halliday, from the Forces Employment Charity provided an update on their work, promoting and supporting the employment of members of the armed forces and veterans community. He identified some of the changes that are being put in place as the career transition partnership contract is renewed. He highlighted the work of Op PROSPER, a UK wide initiative to ensure the long term, sustainable employment of service leavers and veterans.
- There followed some discussion about these initiatives.

Scottish Armed Forces Evidence Research Hub (SAFE&R) Conference 2024
