### The Good Food Nation (Scotland) Bill

#### Stage 1 oral evidence session 3 – policy outcomes

1. The purpose of today's evidence session is to consider how the Good Food Nation (Scotland) Bill will support specific policy outcomes. The evidence session will comprise of two panels; the first will focus on social and economic wellbeing and the second will focus on supply chain resilience and economic development.
